The Marchetti SF260 for the Elementary Flying School

The BEAF ordered 36 SF-260M Marchetti for the EFS at Goetsenhoven. Deliveries took place from 1969 to 1973 in replacement of the old and old biplanes.
The BEAF received 8 more upgraded SF-260M in 1991.
In 1996, the Marchetti of the EFS moved to Bevechstein to become part of the newly created 1st Wing Training.

Fernand JACQUET DFC
Born on November 2, 1928 in Petite-Chapelle.
Student at the Military Academy in October 1950.
Career military aviator until June 1965, then moved to the Military Aviation.
With King Albert I he made numerous reconnaissance flights on the battlefield.
Belgium's first pilot of the Great War, with 1 victory, he ranks fourth in the list of the heroes of the war 14-18.
On March 6, 1918 he is the first Belgian holder of the DFC.
Member of the armed forces, he was actively involved in the cause of civil aviation.
In 1940 (1945), he was an effective intelligence service in contact with Allied services and continued in an escape network for allied airmen shot down in Belgium or incorporated in the Châlet de Hoy in 1942.
Founding member of the Vieilles Tiges of Belgium.
